Wisdom Builds a House

“Through [skillful and godly] wisdom a house [a life, a home, a family] is built, And by understanding it is established [on a sound and good foundation], And by knowledge its rooms are filled with all precious and pleasant riches”

Proverbs 24:3-4 (AMP).

Wisdom is Christ, and Christ is the Word of God. To have Wisdom is to know Christ as your Lord and personal savior. In Christ is hidden all the wisdom of God, and in wisdom is the embodiment of understanding and knowledge. Hear what Wisdom is saying, *“Good counsel and common sense are my characteristics; I am both Insight and the Virtue to live it out. With my help, leaders’ rule, and lawmakers legislate fairly; With my help, governors govern, along with all in legitimate authority. God created man to function in His kind of wisdom, it is expedient that you yield your heart and mental faculties to God, and His Word so that your actions are in sync with the Spirit of wisdom, having the mindset of God and functioning at His level in fulfillment of His plan for your life and impacting others.

The greatness or failure of a man is determined by the kind of wisdom he is functioning in and the level at which he functions in it. The kind of wisdom one functions in also determines the mindset of such an

individual. There is the wisdom of god, man, and the world system.

Three Kinds Of Wisdom

"In whom (Christ) are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge".

Colossians 2:1

There are three kinds of wisdom revealed to us in God's Word. **The first one in Greek is 'Sophia'** which is theoretical knowledge. It is "insight into reality" in all learning, the kind of knowledge we acquire in school. For example, science, and math. This wisdom of God gives you insight beyond the senses.

The second kind of wisdom in Greek is **"Sunesis"** it refers to mental or analytical wisdom and knowledge. Which is a special kind of comprehension, critical ability to analyze, perception, or unusual understanding. It is the ability to understand concepts and see relationships between them. It is a quickness of apprehension; the penetrating consideration within you that precedes actions. This insight of knowledge is an insight into the secrets and mysteries of life.

The third kind of wisdom in Greek is 'Phronesis'. "Phronesis" is also translated as "prudence" and could also be called "practical wisdom" It is "the wisdom of the just". Phronesis' is a fixed mindset or mental attitude, a disposition that predetermines a person's responses to situations and his interpretations of those situations. This is the kind of

wisdom that propels you into action. This is the level the believer is called to live in, so you can deal wisely in the affairs of life. The righteous must have a fixed mindset, and this mindset is the Word of God.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I thank You for filling me with Sophia, Sunesis, and Phronesis—wisdom to understand, analyze, and apply Your truth. I walk in prudence and practical wisdom, making godly decisions and dealing wisely in all life affairs. In the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen

The wisdom of men

“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God”

1 Corinthians 2:4-5 (KJV)

Man's wisdom is based on their philosophy, traditions, religious achievement, self-will, self-fulfillment, self-sufficiency, and self-righteousness, using enticing words; they are looked upon as great thinkers. The wisdom of men regards the word of the cross as foolishness, they follow God on their own terms, according to what suits them. In essence, God has made their wisdom foolish. The Bible says, *“Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ”* (NKJV).

Be on the alert against this kind of wisdom. *“But the natural [unbelieving] man does not accept the things [the teachings and revelations] of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness [absurd and illogical] to him; and he is incapable of understanding them, because they are spiritually discerned and appreciated, [and he is unqualified to judge spiritual matters]”* 1 Corinthians 2:14 (AMP).

The natural man receives not the things of God, that is why we must live by the Spirit of God.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I renounce the wisdom of men and receive the demonstration of Your Spirit and power. My faith stands in the power of God, and I live by divine revelation, not worldly reasoning. In the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen

The wisdom of the world

“For the wisdom of this world is foolishness in God’s sight”

1 Corinthians 3:9a (NIV).

The wisdom of this world are structures that men have established by which they boast before God and man, feeling like it’s by their own might they have achieved these things. This wisdom is foolishness in the sight of God. An example is the tower of Babel, it’s a story of people speaking the same language and decided to build a city and a tower to reach heaven to make a name for themselves and God confused their language (Genesis 11:1-9), another example is the Titanic, a British ocean liner. The builders used the language like “unsinkable”. The ship sank in April 15 1912 on its first trip. Paul said in Galatians 6:14, *“Far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world”* Colossians 2:8 (NASB). We must die to the world and its system, and live for our creator. *“Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God”* 1 Corinthians 2:12 (ESV).

Wisdom, understanding, and knowledge are three essential ingredients for a fruitful and a

productive life: 1 Corinthians 1:24 says, “*But to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God*” (NKJV). Christ Jesus is Wisdom, and all treasures of wisdom are found in Him. Therefore, by believing with your heart and confessing Him as your personal Lord and Savior you have received Wisdom. The wisdom of God by which the world was made, is now functioning in your spirit.

It takes revelation in the knowledge of God’s Word and the application of this knowledge, with the help of the Holy Spirit, to consciously walk in the wisdom of God. Christ while on earth grew in Wisdom and we are to grow in wisdom by giving attention to the Word of God and taking corrections and instructions from the Word to make progress consistently (Joshua 1:8). I see you living an extraordinary life in different levels of success and victory, impacting others.

6

Natural Talents

“Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows”

James 1:17 (NIV).

The almighty God created and empowered man, to be a good steward over His creation. According to Genesis 1:28, *“Then God blessed them and said, “Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth and govern it. Reign over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, and all the animals that scurry along the ground”* (NLT). God has given to every man a unique talent according to their abilities. Ability is a skill to do something. The key is making the most of what you have been given to achieve God's plan for your life.

Natural talents are the inherent talents one is born with. For some people, it runs in their family. These abilities, if not yielded to God, can be manipulated by the devil to cause evil and destruction in the world. The devil bait with money or fame causing people to use their talents to advance the works of Satan; to waste their God given talent.

In Matthew 25:14-30, our Lord Jesus tells us the "Parable of the Talents". The parable is about a master who was about to travel, and before leaving, he entrusted talents to his servants according to the

abilities. The first servant received five talents, the second received two talents, and the third received only one. When the master returned, the servant who had five talents multiplied his and so did the one who had two talents; they both earned 100 percent returns by trading with the talents. But the servant with the one talent did nothing with his; instead, he hid it in the ground and earned nothing. He said, *“I was afraid I would lose your money, so I hid it in the earth. Look, here is your money back”* Matthew 25:25 (NLT).

The rich man rewarded the two who doubled their talents. He addressed the servant who did nothing as wicked and lazy. In Matthew 25:28, the Bible says, *“So take the talent away from him, and give it to the one who has the ten talents”*. This is the consequence of being an unfruitful and unproductive steward. God has given you talents enquire of Him on the strategy to deliver and step out in faith.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I thank You for the natural talents You have placed within me. I commit to using them for Your glory. I step out in faith with Your strategy to be a fruitful and faithful steward of every gift You’ve given me. In the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen

Spiritual Gifts

“As every man hath received the gift, even so, minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.”

1 Peter 4:10 (KJV).

Spiritual gifts are given to us by the Spirit of God once we have been saved. Natural talents are birth by your natural birth. Spiritual gifts on the other hand are birthed when you become born again (spiritually born). This is solely for the believer and it can also be imparted. You discover them as you mature in the things of God. These gifts are divine and supernatural, empowered by the Holy Spirit, enabling the believer to display the God-kind of life. It transcends the natural and causes one to advance supernaturally. “Everyman” in the opening verse from the Greek is “*hekastos*” means every single person, no one excluded. This means that every believer has been supernaturally endowed with gifts from God. The word “received” comes from the Greek word “*lambano*,” which means *to receive into one’s possession or to take into one’s control and ownership*. You are to take a hold of your God-given gifts and talents and make the most of them.

The word “gift” in the opening verse is *charisma*, derived from the word *charis*, the Greek

word for *grace*. But when the word *charis* becomes *charisma*, it speaks of *grace-given gifts*. This means you did not work for these talents or gifts; God gave them to you by His grace by the Spirit of God. Be “faithful stewards” of your God-given gifts in fulfilling God’s plan for our lives. The word “minister” comes from the Greek word *diakoneo*. It portrays *a servant whose primary responsibility is to serve food and wait on tables*. It presents a picture of a waiter or waitress who attends to the needs of others, to please his clients, and therefore, he serves honorably. God expects us to be passionately committed to using our grace-given gifts in such a way that pleases Him and to minister to one another.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I thank You for the supernatural gifts You’ve placed in me by Your Spirit. As a faithful steward, I commit to using them to serve others to glorify You. In the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen

WISDOM NUGGET

“Then Moses said to the Israelites, “See, the LORD has chosen Bezalel son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah, and he has filled him with the Spirit of God, with wisdom, with understanding, with knowledge and with all kinds of skills to make artistic designs for work in gold, silver, and bronze, to cut and set stones, to work in wood and to engage in all kinds of artistic crafts” Exodus 35:30-33 (NIV).

Different Gifts

“We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully”

Romans 12:6-8 (NIV)

God by His Spirit has given believers different gifts, according to His grace given to benefit others and the rewards become your benefit. Look for opportunities to serve by using your gifts in your daily life. When you start, men may not notice you, but God sees, so do it as unto the Lord. The Bible says, *“Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving”* Colossians 3:23–24 (NIV). Allow God to work through you both to will and to do His good pleasure.

God has promised to bless the work of your hands, so do something with your hands. You may start small, but do not remain small. *“Though your beginning was small, Yet your latter end would*

increase abundantly” Job 8:7 (NKJV). Be persistent, do not give up. Those you see today with big businesses today, some started in their garage, others in their dorm room as students. Some tried many times before they became successful. Everything you are using is someone’s talent or gifting: the electronics, cars, furniture, clothing, and accessories.

The Lord Jesus was the son of God, but while being in a form of a man He had to grow in Wisdom. These abilities, gifts, and talents do not develop overnight. They take discipline, practice, education, and effort to help you grow in that area and become a good steward of your God-given gift and talent. Be very careful of negative people regarding your God-given gifts. Be prayerful and persistent, and God will align you with your destiny helpers in fulfilling those desired goals and dreams. Practice listening to God through His Word.

God by His wisdom has made us a solution (salt) to our world. Most often, He will open your eyes to a need, and that need becomes a strong desire in your Spirit. When you recognize that, ask the Lord for strategy, you may be the direct solution or the sponsor for the solution. If you are good at cooking, try cooking different dishes. Download your special dish from God that will make a difference. Consistently enquire of the Lord to show you opportunities to express them. The world is waiting on your products or your services. Use them to promote God’s kingdom on the earth.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I recognize that my gifts are unique and given by Your grace for the good of others. I will use them faithfully and joyfully, growing in excellence and fulfilling Your divine purpose for my life. In the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen

9

You are God's Steward

“For to everyone who has [and values his blessings and gifts from God, and has used them wisely], more will be given, and [he will be richly supplied so that] he will have an abundance; but from the one who does not have [because he has ignored or disregarded his blessings and gifts from God], even what he does have will be taken away”

Matthew 25:29 (AMP).

The word “steward” is from the Greek word “*oikonomos*” and was specifically used to describe the *household manager* for an upper-class, wealthy home. A steward is one that is put in charge to handle the affairs of another. In the biblical sense, God’s children are stewards entrusted with His durable wealth and possessions, to dress it (i.e. manage and use it appropriately) as directed by the Holy Spirit in accomplishing His plans and purposes on earth. God owns the world and its fullness, He gave it to Our Lord Jesus who died and has willed it to us, making us steward of everything.

You are a steward of God’s treasures and He expects you to give Him glory by using your gifts *wisely* and *on time* to meet the needs of those around you and the reward is profits or wages. Glory to God. Everything God gives us is good and there is no

fear in God. It is the work of the devil, trying to rob you of what God gave you using fear of failure. You may have tried many times, do not give up, you are closer to your dream than you started, trust him with the new strategy He is showing you and do it again.

Invest our skills and abilities in producing needed goods and services, and the reward is profit and abundance. Although our abilities, gifts, and talents may vary: minister, author, athlete, public speaker, scientist, artist, farmer, builder, software developer, electrician, engineer, doctors, lawyers, businessman/woman, teachers, musicians, chef. Each one serves a purpose for the well-being of humanity so that we all live a peaceable life.

The issue is not how many talents you have; it is what you are doing with what you have and how you can multiply it, being fruitful and productive. **Twenty-four hours is given to every man to use; do not play lazy by giving all kinds of excuses. The clock is ticking, make the most of the resource called time. The Bible admonishes that** God gave you those talents for you to use, and to multiply, so keep multiplying them to the overflow, living God's dream for you.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I choose to invest the gifts and talents You've given me with diligence and purpose. I declare that I will be fruitful, and multiply what I have been given, and walk in divine abundance. In the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen

10

The Heart Soil

“Then he told them many things in parables, saying:

“A farmer went out to sow his seed.”

Matthew 13:3 (NIV).

A farmer requires a good soil, tools, equipment, seeds, water, and a good climatic condition, to sow and nurture the crop to produce a great harvest. The Word of God is likened to a seed, planted in the “heart soil” of man. *“This is the meaning of the parable: The seed is the Word of God”* Luke 8:11(NIV). The heart is your spiritual soil and God intends the Word seed planted in your heart to transform you. You are to bear much fruit and produce the harvest of all-around prosperity: spirit, soul, and body. Not everyone who hears the Word benefits from it, because it depends on the kind of “heart soil” that is receiving the Word.

The seed of the Word of God is incorruptible; meaning it is full of life and cannot die. But if it does not fall on the right soil, it will not produce God’s desired fruit and could be destroyed by the devil. You will only prosper in the areas you have divine illumination. Constantly examine your heart soil, trust the Holy Spirit leading to help you cultivate your heart soil so you can enjoy your inheritance in Christ. There are four heart soil conditions: wayside heart, stony heart, thorny heart and good heart. The heart is akin to

the soil where the Sower sows the seed. The seed (the Word) has the same power at work in all four-heart soil conditions, but the kind of heart soil determines the harvest. You will only prosper in the areas you receive revelation and acted upon them in faith. Through constant study and meditation, you cultivate a deep appetite for the Word. Meditation causes your imagination to replicate realities.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father I stand in the authority of the Lord Jesus and I rebuke every distraction and attack of the enemy sent to steal the Word from my heart. I resist the devil in the name of the Lord Jesus. I receive divine insight and understanding by Your Spirit/ I declare the Word of God is continuously taking root and producing fruits I walk in revelation and victory, in the name of the Lord Jesus.

WISDOM NUGGET

“Let the Word [spoken by] Christ (the Messiah) have its home [in your hearts and minds] and dwell in you in [all its] richness, as you teach and admonish and train one another in all insight and intelligence and wisdom [in spiritual things, and as you sing] psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, making melody to God with [His] grace in your hearts” Colossians 3:16 AMP.

The wayside or pathway heart

“As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. Listen then to what the parable of the sower means: When anyone hears the message about the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in their heart. This is the seed sown along the path.”

Matthew 13:4, 18-19 (NIV).

The one who hears the Word of God and lacks understanding is in danger of the devil snatching the Word, from producing fruits of righteousness. Just as the farmer had to deal with insects, weeds, and inclement weather. The same way the Word of God also comes under attack by demonic forces (principalities, powers of darkness, rulers, and wicked spirits in high places). We see these forces figuratively as the fowls of the air devouring the seed, shocked by thorns and dried up by the sun. For example: these demonic forces can cause one to have ungodly chatter, words of unbelief, un-forgiveness, offenses and doubt, all of these can choke the seed and cause it to die. Matthew 13:4 used the Word “bird”, to describe what snatches the word away from the heart, but the gospel of Luke helps us to know, the bird is the devil. “Those along the path are the ones who hear, and then the devil

comes and takes away the Word from their hearts, so that they may not believe and be saved” Luke 8: 12(NIV). This is the seed that was sown along the roadside or the pathway.

God has given us the power over the birds of the air, (Genesis 1:26); Spiritual birds of the air (the powers of the air) are agents of the devil, so declare that the birds of the air will not eat nor destroy God’s seed in you in Jesus name. Speak and command them to leave and also resist the devil, in the name of Jesus, and he will flee. Drive them away just like the farmer will drive away the birds who want to destroy his seed. You do not allow the birds to settle down on the soil of your heart to destroy the precious seed of God’s Word. God has given you the power to drive them away, so exercise the power and authority in Christ Jesus. Always pray that the Holy Spirit illuminates your mind to hear and understand the Word and the grace to apply the Word following the instructions of the Word that your profit will appear to all.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I stand in the authority of the name of Jesus, and I rebuke every distraction, attack, and strategies of the enemy sent to steal the Word from my heart. I resist the devil, and I receive divine insight and understanding by Your Spirit. I declare that the Word of God is continuously taking root and producing fruits. I walk in revelation and victory, in the name of the Lord Jesus.

WISDOM NUGGET

“I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.”

The Stony or Rocky Heart

“Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. The seed falling on rocky ground refers to someone who hears the word and at once receives it with joy. But since they have no root, they last only a short time. When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, they quickly fall away.”

Matthew 13:5-6, 20-21 (NIV)

The stony (rocky) soil; this is one who hears the Word and at once welcomes and accepts it with joy; yet it has no real root in him, making the effect temporal. These are those who receive the Word with joy and gladness (for example, they get excited, clapping, shouting), but they do not take time to deliberate on what they heard, neither do they act on the Word, so it did not profit them. Always if you ask such people, about the message they heard, they may say it was a good message, but they will not be able to tell you what the message was about. The sun came up and scourged the Word they received. Meanwhile, the Bible says the sun will not smite us by day (Psalm 121:6).

If your heart soil is full of stones, it does not matter how much incorruptible seeds sown, they will not take root, germinate, grow and bear fruits, because there is no space for the seed. When affliction or trouble or persecution comes on account of the Word, at once that individual begins to distrust and desert the Word of God. These individuals fail in the days of adversity, because they do not have the Word deeply rooted in them.

One major thing the devil is after in the life of the believer is to either pervert the Word of God or to make sure you are distracted from hearing the Word of God. Do not only be excited about the Word, allow the Word to take root for your victorious living. Read Joshua 1:8.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I thank you for this insight given me. I remove every stone of offense, fear, doubt, and distractions from my heart soil. I declare am deeply rooted in Your Word by the ministry of the Holy Spirit my teacher. and I will not fall away in times of trial. I endure and grow strong in faith in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

WISDOM NUGGET

“Those on the rocky ground are the ones who receive the Word with joy when they hear it, but they have no root. They believe for a while, but in the time of testing they fall away” Luke 8: 13(NIV).

13

The Thorny Heart

Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants. The seed falling among the thorns refers to someone who hears the word, but the worries of this life and the deceitfulness of wealth choke the word, making it unfruitful.”

Matthew 13:7, 22 (NIV).

As for what was sown among thorns, this is one who hears the Word, but the cares of the world; such as food, clothing, shelter and the pleasure, delight and glamour and deceitfulness of riches choke and suffocate the Word, and it yields no fruit. Matthew 6:25,31-33 explains, *“Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”* (KJV). The unbelievers are worried about these things because they have no hope, but you child of God, your heavenly Father knows you need all these things

and has made provision for you. Ask and you shall receive so your joy will be full.

In Philippians 4:6-7 the Bible says, *“Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”* (NIV). God is saying do not allow the cares of this life distract you. Instead turn your concerns into prayer, making your request known to God in the name of the Lord Jesus. And the peace of God will guard your heart and mind protecting the Word from being choked by thorns.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I cast every care on You (fear of terror, bills, health, security), because I know you care for me. I thank you for my portion of clothing, shelter and food. I declare that I have more than enough and I am a blessing. Your peace guards my heart and mind. Thank that Your Word is rooted in me and I bear fruits of righteousness in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

WISDOM NUGGET

“Casting all your cares [all your anxieties, all your worries, and all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares about you [with deepest affection, and watches over you very carefully]” (AMP).

14

The Good Heart

Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown. Whoever has ears, let them hear. But the seed falling on good soil refers to someone who hears the word and understands it. This is the one who produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown.”

Matthew 13:8-9, 23 (NIV).

As for what was sown on good soil, this is he who hears the Word and grasps and comprehends it; will bear fruit. Notice the harvest varies, by percentage of yield, have you wondered why? The good soil in this case will always produce a harvest, but the level of yield may vary depending on other factors. We have the 100-fold, 60-fold and 30-fold.

Why will you settle for 30% or 60% increase when you can have a 100%. The seed does not have a problem because it is incorruptible, the issue is how you receive the seed and how you water the seed. This is why there are differences of yield in the good soil. First of all, you need to prepare your heart to be receptive to the seed of the Word. Secondly, the Word you are listening to must be inspired by the Holy Spirit. It could be through songs or preaching, with the

understanding of the purpose for which it is being sent. God will send you teachers to help teach you the Word. The seed must be wisely planted if you expect a 100% yield. Avoid every form of distraction when the seed (the Word) is being planted. For example; if you are a church worker and the Word is being preached, stop everything and focus, this is very vital.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

I declare that I hear, understand, and retain the Word of God. My heart is good soil, and I produce a full harvest thirty, sixty, and a hundredfold. I walk in divine purpose and fruitfulness, in Jesus' name.

WISDOM NUGGET

“But the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the Word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop” Luke 8: 15 (NIV).

“For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives, so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God,” Colossians 9:9-10 (NIV)

Fatherhood

“For I have chosen him, so that he will direct his children and his household after him to keep the way of the Lord by doing what is right and just, so that the Lord will bring about for Abraham what he has promised him.”
Genesis 18:19 (NIV)

Our heavenly Father is the source of life, sustainer, protector, provider, and a guide. He made man in His image and His likeness (Genesis 1:26). Fatherhood comes with these attributes with total reliance on God as the source and originator of all things. A father is one who has his own biological children, adoptive children and or as a father figure. An example is Abraham.

God chose Abraham to “direct his children and his household after him to keep the way of the Lord by doing what is right and just.” The purpose is “so that the Lord will bring about for Abraham what he has promised him”. The Bible says, "Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness" Genesis 15:6 (KJV). God acknowledged Abraham's righteousness, knowing that Abraham will raise and direct his children and his household after him to keep the way of the Lord practicing righteousness and justice. During the time of Abraham, he did not have

the written Word like you do now, he received instructions from the Lord to govern himself and to lead his family. Abraham raised Isaac. Isaac followed the blueprint and raised Jacob, and Jacob raised the twelve. Then fast forward in Christ you are Abraham's seed.

The Bible says, *"Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, and to seeds, as of many; but as of one, and to thy seed, which is Christ."* Galatians 3:16 (KJV). The believer is automatically Abraham's seed and heir according to the promise. As children of the promise, we are called to raise godly children. Fatherhood comes with the responsibility of nurturing and guiding one's children and household as an active participant. Godly fathers like Abraham are responsible for leading their children and household in a Godly way, with the guidance and direction of the Holy Spirit, teaching the Word of God and shaping the values and moral character of their children to walk in the blessings of Abraham, to impact generations to come, transcending to our communities and the society at large

Can God count on you fathers as he did Abraham? Children are an heritage of the Lord (Psalm 127:3), so without the help of God, fatherhood would be a pain. The Spirit of God is calling out all godly fathers to solemnly reflect on their responsibility, take forgiveness on their inactions, obtain mercy and find grace to help with their god ordained responsibilities of raising godly children.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I thank You for the honor and responsibility of fatherhood. I receive grace, wisdom, and strength to lead my children and household in righteousness and truth, just like father Abraham. I declare that I am raising godly children who are walking in the way of the Lord and inherit the promise, in the name of the Lord Jesus.

“And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee.” Genesis 17:7 (KJV)

Raising Godly Children

“Didn’t the LORD make you one with your wife? In body and spirit, you are his. And what does he want? Godly children from your union. So guard your heart; remain loyal to the wife of your youth.”

Malachi 2:15 (NLT).

God is looking for godly children from the union. In Ephesians 5:23, the Bible says, *“For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior.”* (NIV). God has set the husband as head of the woman, with responsibilities. These responsibilities are not limited to providing food, clothing and shelter

The principal responsibility of the father is to model Christ and raise his children in the way of the Lord. Proverbs 22:6 says, *“Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it”* (KJV). The way is Christ, *“Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.”* John 14:6 (KJV). Christ is the Word of God. John 1:14 says, *“The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.”* (NIV), So, if you train the child in the Word of God, he will not depart from it, because the Word abides forever.

Deuteronomy 6:6-7 says, *“These commandments that I give you today are to be on your*

hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up." (NIV). The verse is all about integrating God's Word into your daily family life. Having personal and family devotion daily. You train the child to cultivate love for God, the fruits of the spirit as attributes of their divine nature, understanding basic principles: the ministry of the Holy Spirit, prayer, worship, praise, meditation on the Word, faith proclamation, giving. importance of serving God and fellowship with the saints in the house of God. You model how to live out the word by experience.

May be your children are all grown and have left the house and you are wondering what to do. God says, "*And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm...*" (Joel 2:25). Pray that God restore the years the enemy has stolen from them because of your ignorance or inaction. Also, that God align godly people in their path to help them. Every opportunity you get to interact with them plant the Word seed and water it with prayer God will bring the increase.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I thank you for the privilege of parenting. I receive grace to train my children in a godly way. I pray for children all around the world who did not have the opportunity to be raised in a godly way, that the message of the gospel will reach them in their schools, and through their peers unto salvation. To walk in the

WISDOM NUGGET

“Lo, children are an heritage of the Lord: and the fruit of the womb is his reward” Psalm 127:3 (KJV)

The Fruit of the Spirit

*“But the **fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.”*
Galatians 5:22-23 (NIV)

The fruit of the spirit is the character trait of the new creation (believer in Christ), which is evidence of a transformed life by the Word and the ministry of the Holy Spirit. It sets you apart from unbelievers. An ungodly life is one controlled by the sinful nature: *“The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.”* Galatians 5:19-21 (NIV). These are the desires of the flesh and its passions, but those who belong to Christ have crucified them (Galatians 5:24). *“So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.”* Galatians 5:16 (NIV). You are in God’s image and likeness, but you must grow into it consciously, being transformed by the renewing of your mind, determined to grow daily.

All the fruit of the spirit is produced by your union and communion with Christ. Jesus says, *“Remain*

in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." John 15:4-5(NIV). The vine produces the nutrients for the branches to bear fruit, but the branches must remain connected to the vine.

The Holy Spirit helps you to understand and apply the Word of God, which transforms and molds you to conform to the image of Christ experientially. Cultivate the fruits by prayerfully and consistently examining your actions, consciously deepening your understanding, be discipline by the Word as you are led by the Holy Spirit. Bearing much fruit makes you an effective witness of Christ, bringing many to salvation.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I thank you for creating me in Your image and likeness, and expressing your divine nature in me to my world. I receive grace to bear much fruit, displaying the character of Your Spirit while abiding in the vine. In the name of the Lord Jesus.

WISDOM NUGGET

LOVE

“A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this, all people will know that you are my disciples if you have love for one another.”

John 13:34

The Greek word for this kind of love is *agape*. Agape is the God kind of love. It is pure, selfless and self-sacrificing. It always seeks the best for others. Love is spiritual but can be expressed in words, conduct, substance and honor. God is Love, and He expressed His love for men that he sends His only son to pay the sin debt for all men, to reconcile us to Himself (John 3:16, Romans 5:8). The day you were born again, it was love (God) that gave birth to you. If love gave birth to you, you are love's son, born with the attributes of love. Love is a major characteristic of discipleship.

To walk in love, you must cultivate love by understanding the length, breath, width, and heights of love, then sow love as a seed so you can reap the harvest of love by experience. 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 explains the character and nature of love. *“Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is*

not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never ends...." (ESV). See how love expresses itself in patience, kindness, it rejoices with the truth, love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. This verses also helps you to know what love is not, "*love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrongdoing,*" Examine your love life and walk in the agape love which is unconditional.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I thank you that I am born again and walking in your love. I ask Lord Holy Spirit to teach me the different dimensions of love. I receive grace to cultivate and walk in love towards all men. In the name of the Lord Jesus.

WISDOM NUGGET

"Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. 1 John 4:7-11 (NIV).

JOY

“You will show me the path of life; In Your presence
is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures
forevermore.”

Psalm 16:11 (NKJV)

Joy is a character trait, a fruit of your spirit as a child of God. The Greek word “Chara” means joy, gladness, or delight. In God’s presence is fullness of joy, and you dwell in God, because in Him you live, move and have your being. This means you carry His presence everywhere you go, so you are to manifest the joy of the Lord everywhere. Cultivating living a joyful life consciously sets you apart. One of the benefits of joy is strength. “The joy of the LORD is your strength.” Nehemiah 8:10 (NIV). It is with this strength you draw from your wells of salvation. The Bible says in Isaiah 12:3, “With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.” (NIV). Salvation is a deep well, full of all the benefits in Christ Jesus. Benefits like: health, long life, marriage, divine direction, wisdom, counsel, and prosperity. Imagine a well full of water of all these things and you are very thirsty for them. The bucket and the rope are available by the well, but you need strength to draw from the well. This is why Paul says, “Rejoice always” 1 Thessalonians 5:16 (NKJV). Joy is

beyond happiness. One becomes happy when a desired event happens. But joy is a state of being, independent of circumstance whether good or bad, because you know who is in control (God).

James 1:2-3 says, “My brethren count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.” (NKJV). Joy helps you to live above the challenges life produces, fruits of patience. In John 15:11 Jesus said, “I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete.” (NIV). Our Lord Jesus drew strength from Joy and endured the cross which is the greatest suffering in human history, despising the shame for your salvation. John 16:24 says, “Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.” (NIV). Joy is perfected by making your request known to God through prayer, thank Him for answered prayer in the name of the Lord Jesus.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I thank You for Your love and the joy of your salvation through Christ Jesus. With joy I draw from my wells of salvation everything I require: divine health, divine protection, divine direction, divine supply.... I declare all things are mine and my joy is full. In the name of the Lord Jesus.

WISDOM NUGGET

“Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.” Hebrews 12:2 (KJV)

Peace

*“Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace
with God through our Lord Jesus Christ”*

Romans 5:1(KJV)

The Lord Jesus Christ is the prince of peace and the source of your peace. This peace came to you as a product of your salvation. This kind of peace is supernatural beyond human understanding; it is an unshakeable inner calm even in the mist of challenging times. The Greek word *eiréné* is peace; The Hebrew word for peace is *Shalom* meaning wholeness, completeness, well-being, rest, and prosperity (Jeremiah 33:6). Peace is a state where every aspect of your life is working in alignment with God’s divine order, a fruit of the born-again believer. Jesus said, *“Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.”* John 14:27 (NIV). The Lord Jesus gave you His peace at salvation, yours is to acknowledge the peace you have and maintain the peace.

To maintain the peace, Philippians 4:6-7 says, *“Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”* (NIV). You must avoid anxiety by turning your issues into prayer

and petition, making your request known unto God, and God's peace will protect your heart and mind in Christ Jesus. Isaiah 26:3 says, *"You will keep him in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You."* (NKJV). Another way of maintaining the peace, is to keep your focus on the Word of God. Do not consider the cares of life, instead casting all your cares on Him and follow the instructs of the Holy Spirit for your solution.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Lord, I thank You for the gift of peace that surpasses all understanding. I choose to cast every care on You and allow Your peace to guard my heart and mind.

WISDOM NUGGET

"For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity." Grow in Peace

“Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord”

2 Peter 1:2

You also must grow in peace, Peace is multiplied to you through meditation on the Word of God, and by acting on the instructions of the Word. Colossians 3:15 says, “Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.” (NIV). This verse means, you are responsible for allowing the peace of God to govern your heart.

You practice living a peaceable life and also proclaiming peace over your home, community, city, nation and situations. Isaiah 55:12 says, “*For you shall go out with joy, and be led out with peace; The mountains and the hills Shall break forth into singing before you, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.*” (NKJV). Let peace lead you; you are to express and promote the peace of God everywhere and in everyplace. You cannot give what you do not have, but because you have peace you are able to give peace.

Matthew 5:9 says, “*Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.*” (NKJV). If you profess to be a child of God, then you are a peace maker. Romans 12:18 says, “If it be

possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men." (KJV). Be determined to live at peace with all men, this is a reflection of the character of Christ to your world. "the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace." James 3:18 (KJV). You reap what you sow, so sow peace and reap a good measure of peace, pressed down and running over from men. No man shall trouble you in Jesus name.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I thank you that for your peace in me by reason of faith in Christ Jesus. I let this peace of God rule my heart and mind. I declare that I am led by your peace and I give peace everywhere I go in the name of the Lord Jesus.

WISDOM NUGGET

"Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests." Luke 2:14 (NIV)

"Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost." Romans 15:13 (KJV)

Patience or Longsuffering

*“Be completely humble and gentle; be patient,
bearing with one another in love.”*

Ephesians 4:2, NIV

Patience is a state of enduring hardship or provocation without becoming angry or retaliating immediately. The Greek word “makrothumia” translates to patience, forbearance, longsuffering, or steadfastness. The act of patience is to hold yourself in, staying in a calm state until you are able to respond and not react to a situation. The good news is that the Holy Spirit is working in partnership with you to produce the fruit of patience.

James 1:2-4 says, “My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.” (KJV). Challenges are the trying of your faith which is a blessing in disguise. They are stepping stones for your elevation, producing patience in you. So count it all joy and let patience have her perfect work, that you may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.

The Lord Jesus has overcome on your behalf and has given you all it takes to live the victorious life. Proverbs 24:10 says, “If thou faint in the day of

adversity, thy strength is small.” (KJV). Examples of the days of adversities: deceased loved one, divorce, unemployment, accident, misunderstanding, and financial difficulties. In the mist of these, remember the joy of the Lord is your strength. Learn to keep your composure.

It takes patience to run your life's race to the end. Hebrews 12:1 says, “Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us” (KJV). You will finish well for your crown.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I receive grace to run my race with perseverance, knowing that patience is producing completeness in me. I will not faint, for the joy of the Lord is my strength.

WISDOM NUGGET

“Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners of whom I am the worst. But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display his immense patience as an example for those who would believe in him and receive eternal life.” 1 Timothy 1:15-16 (NIV)

Kindness

*“Be kind and compassionate to one another,
forgiving each other, just as in Christ God
forgave you.”*

Ephesians 4:32, (NIV)

Kindness is a character trait of the believer expressed in acts of generosity showing compassion towards others, kindness is fueled by genuine love of Christ. Greek *Chrestotes* translates to kindness, goodness, or gentleness. Colossians 3:12-14 says, *“Put on then, as God’s chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.”*

Romans 2:4b explains, “... not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance? (KJV). God's kindness are intended to lead people to repentance.

Micah 6:8 Says *“He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?”* (ESV). Words come

from the heart; reveal your personality and out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks, so fill your heart with kind words, and expressions. Speak kindly always, from your heart using kind words, not flattery. Proverbs 21:21 say “Whoever pursues righteousness and kindness will find life, righteousness, and honor.” (ESV)

Goodness

Ephesians 2:10 (KJV)

Goodness is a character trait of a born-again believer. The Greek word "agathosune" is most commonly translated as goodness. An aspect of God's nature is His goodness. Moses wanted to know who God is and He told Moses *“And he said, I will make all my goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee”* Exodus 33:19 (KJV). Salvation is based on good works which is the result of good news functioning in you, bringing glory to God. Matthew 5:16 says, *“Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.”* (KJV). In the days of the Lord Jesus, the people saw the light of the kingdom through the good works He did bringing glory to God.

You are graced to do the same good works and even greater, to be generous and ready to share. *“Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.”* Galatians 6:9-10 (NIV)

1 Corinthians 1:8-9 (NIV)

God’s is faithful to Himself. His faithfulness is to His commitment to be God and he cannot deny Himself (2 Timothy 2:11-13). He is also faithful to His Word. Deuteronomy 7:9 says, “Know therefore that the Lord your God is God; he is the faithful God, keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commandments” (NIV). God is faithful to keep His Word. He does not change, His is consistent, the same yesterday, today and forever. and to those He has called into fellowship to His son Jesus. He is faithful to strengthen and keep you from evil. 2 Thessalonians 3:3 “But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one.” (NIV)

Faithfulness is your nature as a new creation. Faithfulness is displayed in your commitment, diligence, and consistency in your assignment from a cheerful heart born out of love as unto God. Faithfulness goes before greatness. Proverbs 22:29 says, “Seest thou a man diligent in his business? he shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before mean men.” (KJV). And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men (Colossians 3:23).

The primary purpose of your faithfulness is for the furtherance of the Gospel

1 Corinthians 4:2 “Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.” (KJV). God requires of His children to be faithful. Romans 3:3-4 says, “*What if some were unfaithful? Will their unfaithfulness nullify God’s faithfulness? Not at all! Let God be true, and every human being a liar.*” (NIV). Gods’ faithfulness does not change even when we are unfaithful by walking in disobedience, because it is His nature. With His loving kindness, he restores us. If you are out of character in your faithfulness, God is reaching out to restore you. Receive His forgiveness and live faithfully and purposefully.

Proverbs 3:3-4 says, “*Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. Then you will win favor and a good name in the sight of God and man.*” (NIV)

2 Thessalonians 3:3 says, “But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one.” (NIV).

Gentleness

“As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.”

Ephesians 4:1–3 (NIV)

Gentleness is a divine fruit of the spirit, an attribute of God in the born-again believer. The Greek word “*prautēta*” is translated as “gentleness,” which involves acting tenderly or softly and having an attitude of humility. The Lord Jesus Christ is the supreme embodiment of gentleness, He says “Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.” Matthew 11:29 (NIV). He is your role model and you are learning humility and gentleness from Him. Paul attesting said, “Now I Paul myself beseech you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ” 2 Corinthians 10:1 (KJV). You have these virtues in you through Christ Jesus, but you must cultivate them consciously.

Gentleness is cultivated and displayed through your fellowship with God by the Holy Spirit and heeding to the instructions of the Word of God. Gentleness is not weakness or the absence of strength but rather it is a spiritual virtue which gives you added strength. Gentle people walk in the wisdom of God, they overlook offense, avoid quarrelling and show courtesy to all people (Titus 3:2, James 3:17). You are endowed with “a spirit of gentleness” (1 Corinthians

4:21; Galatians 6:1). Philippians 4:5 says, “Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.” (NIV). Your gentleness must be seen by all people, through your words, and conduct. The Bible says, “A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.” Proverbs 15:1 (NIV). You are to respond gently to situations and not react. 2 Timothy 2:24 -25 says, “The Lord’s servant must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring evil, correcting his opponents with gentleness.” (ESV). Learn to correct your opponent gently.

Always be ready to provide an answer for their faith, but do so wisely and righteously in gentleness. Proverbs 15:4 says, “A gentle tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit.” A gentle, spoken word will often bring life and healing. This is why your words must be wisely chosen seasoned with salt and grace to promote calm responses. 1 Timothy 6:11 says, “But you, man of God, flee from all this, and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness.” (NIV). You are to flee the lust of the flesh and the love of money and cultivate the following virtues: righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness. Purpose in your heart, to “always to be gentle toward everyone.” Titus 3:1-2 (NIV). Let your gentleness be known to all people.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I acknowledge the spirit of gentleness at work in me. I choose to reflect Christ gentleness in my words, actions, and responses. Walking in humility, overlooking offenses, and giving corrections in wisdom and gentleness. My gentleness is evident to all, bringing healing and peace wherever I go. In the name of the Lord Jesus.

WISDOM NUGGET

“But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.” 1 Peter 3:15-16 (NIV)

Self Control

“The end of all things is at hand; therefore, be self-controlled and sober-minded for the sake of your prayers.”

1 Peter 4:7 (ESV).

Self-control is a fruit of the spirit of the born-again believer functioning in the image of God (Galatians 5:23). This is an attribute of your divine nature. The Lord Jesus, is your source of true self-control. The idea of Christ centered self-control presumes the presence of some desires, passions and appetites (e.g. love, anger, food) within us that needs to be restrained or indulged appropriately.

Galatians 5:16 says, “This I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.” (KJV). One who is self-controlled is subject to discipline by the Word of God and marvelously helped by the Holy Spirit. You are also disciplined to resist the flesh and have control over your behaviors, impulses, emotions and the mind (1 Corinthians 9:24-27). Romans 6:6 says, “We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin.” (ESV). Sin no longer rules over you because you are dead to sin in Christ Jesus.

The Bible says, “*A man without self-control is like a city broken into and left without walls.*” Proverbs 25:28 (ESV). A man who is not self-controlled has no defense or protection, and can easily be attacked or destroyed. Proverbs 16:32 says, “He that is slow to anger is better than the

mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit, than he that taketh a city." (KJV). Examine your life and cultivate self-control acting on the word and receive the ministry of the Holy Spirit. Christ's return is "at hand", believers are to be self-controlled and sober-minded, devoted to prayer and spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ. You are the light of the world, so let your light shine, glorifying God.

PRAYER / CONFESSION

Dear Father, I receive the grace to walk in self-control with the help of the Holy Spirit. I discipline my thoughts, emotions, and actions to align with Your Word. I have rule over my spirit, sober minded, focused, and pleasing to You, in the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen

WISDOM NUGGET

"For this very reason, make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue, and virtue with knowledge, and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with steadfastness, and steadfastness with godliness, and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love. For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they keep you from being ineffective or unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ." 2 Peter 1:5–8 (ESV)

God has the master plan for your life

"For I know the plans and thoughts that I have for you," says the Lord, 'plans for welfare and peace and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call on Me and you will come and pray to Me, and I will hear [your voice] and I will listen to you."

Jeremiah 29:11-12 (AMP)

God has the excellent master plan, for your life. You are not an accident going somewhere to happen. God divinely orchestrated your life thoughtfully in His image, His plan is to prosper you and not to harm you. You matter in the agenda of God, but because He gave you a will to make choices, you are expected to call on Him and pray to Him regarding the master plan for your life and God will show you. Your cooperation is required in discovering the master plan, to walk in the light of it by choice.

To become acquainted: 1) prayer with all manner of prayer in the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 6:18). 2) give attention to the study and meditation of the Word. 3) be yielded to the ministry of the Holy Spirit. Mostly, God will show you the big picture, but the journey requires your consistent inquiry of Him every step of the way, following the instructions. Proverbs 3:5-6 says, "Trust in and rely confidently on the Lord with all your heart. And do not rely on your own insight or understanding.

In all your ways know and acknowledge and recognize Him,

And He will make your paths straight and smooth [removing obstacles that block your way]." (AMP). You must trust and

confidently rely on God, and He will progressively bring you into the big picture. Study the life of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, David, and the Lord Jesus.

Diligence is required: You will be given different roles or assignments leading to the big picture. Be diligent as a good steward, and do all things as unto the Lord without murmuring or complaining, because God sees the heart. Your path is that of progress: Proverbs 4:18 says, “But the path of the just (righteous) is like the light of dawn, that shines brighter and brighter until [it reaches its full strength and glory in] the perfect day.” By walking in the way of the Lord, you are able to see your way forward in your life path. His light shines brightly and becomes more compelling, more relevant, more fruitful. Your progress will now reflect the glory like the noonday sun.

God foreknew, predestined you to be conformed into Christ

“For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.”

Romans 8:29 (NIV)

God foreknew, predestined you to be conformed into the image of His son Jesus Christ. This is so, that the Lord Jesus would be the firstborn among many brethren (the body of Christ). The three great works of God that makes all things will work together for your good. He foreknew 2) He predestined 3) We become conformed to Christ. Foreknowledge and predestination are already accomplished in you. Conforming you to the image of Christ is a present and an ongoing process. Foreknowledge, is "sovereign", God has loved you, known you, and has chosen you, before the foundation of the world. Predestination means God has decided and ordain ahead what you would become in this world before you existed. The purpose of God's foreknowledge and predestination is to conformed you to the image of His Son Jesus, so that He would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.

The events of your life are designed by God, because of His foreknowledge and predestination is at work in you. Romans 8:28 says, “*And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose*” (NIV). It is true that due to your disobedience, you open the door giving the devil a footstool which might lead to a detour in your life. When

you come in alignment through repentance, taking forgiveness, God will work all those situations together for your good. It is like you are driving using a GPS and you take a detour or you miss your route. You may also miss your way due to loss of signal. When you gain signal, the GPS rerouted you back on course from where you are to your destination. You will agree with that, God who gave the brain to make the GPS, would do much better by making everything work together for your good. The key is to conformed you to the image of His Son Jesus. Paul says in Romans 8:30, *"Those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified,"* Because predestination is at work in you, God called you and by believing in the Lord Jesus, you were justified. Your life is designed by God to move from one level of glory to another, the key is to remain at the center of God's will for your life.

SCRIPTURE

“Do not store up for yourselves [material] treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in and steal; for where your treasure is, there your heart [your wishes, your desires; that on which your life centers] will be also” (Matthew 6:19-21 AMP).

MESSAGE

The day you got born again, your heavenly account was activated. Just like you opened your earthly account and are expected to deposit money as an investment that draws interest, and you withdraw when you need it. You are expected to make deposits into your heavenly account through your offerings, giving, and service to God and men.

Giving to God is the way you will have treasures in your heavenly account. God says prove me now, if I will not open you the flood-gates of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it, he will also rebuke the devourer for your sake (Malachi 3:10-12). He also said you he would have good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over. He will cause men to give unto your bosom (Luke 6:38). He said if you serve me, I will bless your bread and water (Exodus 24:25). Bearing fruits of righteousness (Galatians 5:22-23)

As offerings: you give your First Fruit, Tithes, Freewill Offerings, and also give to the poor, charity, serving God and men Bearing fruits of righteousness. In all these, you are laying up treasures in heaven, making deposits in your heavenly account. Your heavenly account is not subject to theft, robbery, or inflation. As you make deposits into the treasury of heaven, you withdraw as needed.

Keep on laying up treasures in your heavenly account for where your treasure is, "there your heart, your wishes, your desires, and that on which your life centers will be also." I see you having complete sufficiency in everything in Jesus' name. Amen.

I thank you for making all grace and every favor and earthly blessing come to me in abundance. I have complete sufficiency in everything and abundance for every good work and act of charity. In the name of the Lord Jesus.

WISDOM NUGGET

“God is able to make all grace [every favor and earthly blessing] come in abundance to you, so that you JUNE always [under all circumstances, regardless of the need] have complete sufficiency in everything [being completely self-sufficient in Him], and have an abundance for every good work and act of charity.” 2 Corinthians 9:8 AMP “And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye JUNE prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.” Romans 12:2

SALVATION

*All of us like sheep have gone astray, we have
turned, each one, to his own way; But
the Lord has caused the wickedness of us all [our
sin, our injustice, our wrongdoing] to fall on Him
[instead of us]"*
— Isaiah 53:6 (AMP)

The whole human race went astray because of the sin of the first Adam, and God laid all our sins on Jesus. 2 Corinthians 5:21 explains, *"He made Christ who knew no sin to [judicially] be sin on our behalf so that in Him we would become the righteousness of God [that is, we would be made acceptable to Him and placed in a right relationship with Him by His gracious lovingkindness]"* (AMP). Our Lord Jesus took your place legally so you would become the righteousness of God.

To receive Him, you must be born again: *Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again."* John 3:3, 7 (KJV). The term "born again" was originally used by

Jesus to express the necessity for man's spiritual rebirth. *"But to as many, as did receive and welcome Him, He gave the right [the authority, the privilege] to become children of God, that is, to those who believe in (adhere to, trust in, and rely on) His name"* John 1:12 (APM). To be born again is by receiving Jesus as your Lord and Savior.

The new birth is a one-time experience. By choosing the Lord Jesus as Lord of your life, you receive remission of sin. Remission is the complete removal of sin which the blood of Jesus gives, giving you a new nature of righteousness, and giving you right standing before God without a sense of guilt or condemnation. The Bible says, *"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation"* Romans 10:9-10 (KJV). Confession is your response in agreement with God's Word.

Just as natural newborn baby's desire milk, spiritual newborns must also desire the Word of God, to build up faith, and grow their spirits. When we are born again, it is our spirit that is born again. Your flesh and thoughts are still the same. Therefore, the Word of God is important to renew your mind (Romans 12:2) so you can think the way God thinks (Romans 12:3) and live the Spirit life.

I pray that God our Father grants you revelation in the knowledge of Himself, causing grace and peace to be multiplied to you. I pray that you are protected from the evil one and that you stand perfect in the will of God in the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen.

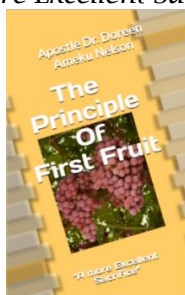

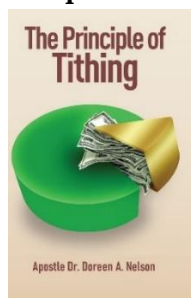

fruit simply refers to the initial or the first harvest of one's labor or services rendered.

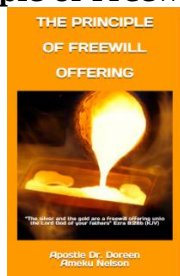
The Principle of Tithing

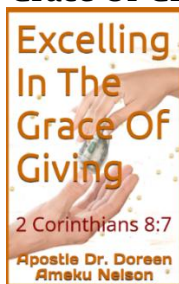

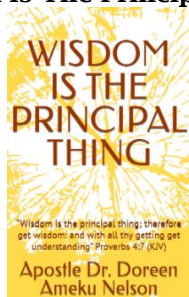
Excelling In The Grace Of Giving

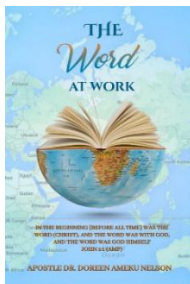

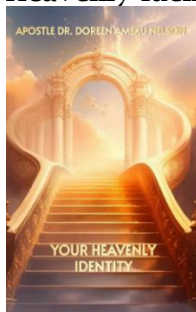
The Word At Work
