### 1

#### Reigning as King-Priest I

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“And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen”  
Revelation 1:6.

Every believer is a king-priest unto God. This began the day you made Jesus Christ the Lord of your life. For there to be a King and a Priest, there must be a kingdom. God’s kingdom is invisible to the natural eyes, but it exists and it’s eternal. This kingdom resides in the heart of every believer. God is a Spirit and His kingdom is spiritual. 1 Corinthians 15:50 explains, “Now this I say, brethren that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.” (KJV) Unless you are born again, you cannot inherit the kingdom of God.

In John 3:3, 5, “*Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.*” (KJV). God is in heaven and His sovereignty reigns over the heavens and all the earth. God called believers the kingdom of priests: in His kingdom we are all priests. 1 Peter 2:9, says, “But you

are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a dedicated nation, [God's] own purchased, special people, that you may set forth the wonderful deeds and display the virtues and perfections of Him Who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light" (AMPC). Believers are the royal family of God on this earth with the kingdom mandate to colonize the earth from the heavenly realm, where we are seated with the Lord Jesus at the right hand of the Father. As a royal, you go out and display your value and influence to benefit others, bringing glory to God.

### 2

### Responsibility of the King Priest

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“But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a dedicated nation, [God’s] own purchased, special people, that you may set forth the wonderful deeds and display the virtues and perfections of Him Who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light”  
1 Peter 2:9 (AMPC).

In God’s kingdom, our primary responsibility is to worship God in spirit and in truth because God desires our fellowship. The Bible says, “God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.” John 4:24 (KJV). To worship God in the Spirit is to pray in tongues, and to worship God in truth is to use the Word of God (truth) in ascribing praise and adoration to His name.

Another responsibility of the king-priest is to pray. Ephesians 6:18 says, “Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;” (KJV). Pray that the Gospel of Jesus Christ has a free course and is glorified in the nations of the World, in Jesus’ Name. You also pray that the will of God be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Kings rule with words. The Bible says, “The king’s command is backed by great power, and no one

can withstand it or question it.” Ecclesiastes 8:4 (TLB)  
The king-priest makes decrees with God's Word through faith proclamation, engaging angelic activities. When you make decrees in the name of Jesus Christ, you are backed by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Priests have the responsibility of making God's Word known. “For the priest's lips should keep knowledge, and they should seek the law at his mouth: for he is the messenger of the LORD of hosts” Malachi 2:7 (KJV). The priest is the messenger of the Lord. Every believer is a minister of reconciliation, mandated to take the gospel to your world. Receive a fresh grace of Christ to take your place as King-Priest and reign

### Transformed by the Word

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*“And do not be conformed to this world [any longer with its superficial values and customs], but be transformed and progressively changed [as you mature spiritually] by the renewing of your mind [focusing on godly values and ethical attitudes], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His plan and purpose for you]”*

Romans 12:2 (AMP)

The Lord Jesus is the Word of God, and the Holy Spirit is the interpreter of God’s Word. The Holy Spirit is your teacher who divinely illuminates your heart, enabling the Word to penetrate into your heart, and helping you explore the hidden riches in Christ Jesus. The Word of God is the totality of God: His opinions, thoughts, ideas, treaties, knowledge, wisdom, counsel, ability, quality, personality, plans, and purposes. The Word of God is our instruction manual, like a compass or GPS for steering the course of your life, and it contains God’s plans and purposes for your live. Your role is to avail ourselves to be taught by the Holy Spirit and become student of the Word.

God’s plan and direction for your life is already programmed inside you. It will take your knowledge of the Word of God to activate and walk in His plan and

purpose for your life. It takes one who is born again and taught by the Holy Spirit to understand the Word. *“Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.”* Psalm 119:105 (KJV). With the Word as the light shining in your path, you cannot miss your way and you will not stumble, because He leads you in the path of righteousness, and you are able to make godly choices using the Word.

### **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Father, I receive grace not to conform to the world, I yield to the transforming power of Your Word by the Holy Spirit, being renewed in the spirit of my mind. I declare that the Word is my light and my compass. I walk in the good, acceptable, and perfect will of God for my life daily. In the name of the Lord Jesus, Amen.

## **You Are the Reflection of Your Mind**

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*“That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; And be renewed in the spirit of your mind.” Ephesians 4:22-23*

The day you got born again, it was your spirit that was born again, but your mind and your soul are still carnal and need to be renewed to conform to the character of your spirit through revelation in the knowledge of Christ (the Word of God). As a new creation, the character of your personality should be controlled by your spirit, but your mind needs to align with your spirit, which is why renewing your mind is key to your transformation. You are to work on your mind and change its contents by deleting the carnal or wrong thinking you had before you were born again and replacing it with God's thoughts through meditation on His Word.

God has instituted the fivefold ministry (Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastors and Teachers) to perfect the body of Christ through the ministry of the Word of God. With the help of the Holy Spirit, as your teacher, you can understand the Word of God and live by it consciously. Judge everything by the Word of God and focus your mind on things that are

pure, just, honest, lovely, virtuous, and of good report (Philippians 4:8).

One major thing the enemy is after in your life is the Word of God in your heart. God says His Word will be written on your heart, but you are responsible for meditating on the Word and driving it into your heart through your faith proclamation and guarding the Word in your heart, through praying in tongues and following the instructions of the Word. You will know what to do in any given situation to experience victory in every area of your life, such as your health, finances, business, education, family, and ministry.

## PRAYER / CONFESSION

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Father, I put off the old man with its corrupt desires, and I renew my mind daily with Your Word. My thoughts align with Your truth. I think on things that are true, noble, just, pure, lovely, and praiseworthy. I prosper even as my soul prospers. I meditate on Your truth and walk in the light of Your wisdom. In the name of the Lord Jesus, Amen.

### **The Word of God is the mirror of God**

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*“But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord”*  
2 Corinthians 3:18 (KJV).

The Word of God is the mirror of God by which He shows you who you are in Him. As you look, you are changed into the consciousness of the image of God from glory to glory. For example, your revelation of divine health brings you into the realms of divine health, provisions, protection, and prosperity in our salvation. Romans 8:1 says, *“There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.”* He destroyed the hold of sin over you. With this knowledge, you walk free of any condemnation.

Romans 6:14 says, *“For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.”* (KJV). The issue of sin has been dealt with once and for all by the death of Jesus Christ. You have victory over sin, because the sin nature is dead, and you are alive in Christ.

### **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Father, I thank you for the reflection granted me in the mirror of Your Word. As I look, I am changed

from glory to glory by the Spirit reflecting Christ to my world. I am the righteousness of God, see myself victorious, and complete in You. Sin no longer has dominion over me. I live in freedom, boldness, and confidence. I walk in the reality of who I am in Christ. In the name of the Lord Jesus, Amen.

## **Water Baptism**

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*“Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore, we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.”*

Romans 6:3-4 (KJV)

Water baptism is one of the sacraments of the church of the Lord Jesus Christ and is very significant. The word ‘baptize’ is derived from the Greek word ‘baptizo’, which means to “dip completely” or “immerse completely into”; it is not sprinkling or dotting the forehead with water. You have to be born again before you are water baptized. Water baptism is a testimony of your faith in the death, burial, and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ. To be water baptized is to be immersed completely into the water, which is an outward expression of being identified with Christ in His death, burial, and resurrection. It also symbolizes your separation from the world.

## **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Thank You, Father, for the gift of salvation and the outward testimony of water baptism. Being baptized

into Christ, I acknowledge being buried with Him and raised into newness of life. My old self is crucified, and I now live for Christ. I walk daily in the power of the resurrection, separated from the world and dedicated to You. My life brings you glory. In the name of the Lord Jesus, Amen.

### WISDOM NUGGET

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*“Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”* Matthew 28:19.

## Significance of Water Baptism

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*“He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned”.*

Mark 16:16 (KJV)

Water Baptism is an act of your faith, and a public announcement that one has become a Christian and identifies oneself with the body of Christ. Water baptism is an outward and visual representation of the inward new birth that happened at the time of conversion. It is a physical expression of an inner spiritual reality. Water baptism is a one-time act.

In 1 Corinthians 10:1-2 the Bible says, *“Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea, and were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea”* (KJV). The children of Israel passing through the Red Sea on dry ground was symbolic of water baptism, a separation from Egypt, which is a type of the world. The Bible says they did it by faith (Hebrews 11:29).

1 Peter 3:21 explains, “And that water is a picture of baptism, which now saves you, not by removing dirt from your body, but as a response to God from a clean conscience. It is effective because of the resurrection of Jesus Christ” (NLT). The minister of God baptizes you in the Name of the Lord Jesus by

dipping you into water, which symbolizes the Lord's death and burial, which means you are buried with Him by baptism into death, and then when the minister brings you out of the water, it symbolizes you are resurrected with Christ. Glory to God.

## **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Father, I thank You for the significance of water baptism. By faith, I declare that I am one with Christ in His death and resurrection. I boldly profess my faith in Jesus and my identification with the body of Christ. Just as Israel passed through the sea and left Egypt behind, so am I separated from the world. I am separated unto You, and I walk in the power of a new life. In the name of the Lord Jesus, Amen.

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*"For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ". Galatians 3:27*

## The Three Witnesses

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*“This is the one who came by water and blood—Jesus Christ. He did not come by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth. For there are three that testify; the Spirit, the water and the blood; and the three are in agreement.”*

1 John 5:6 - 9 (NIV)

The three witnesses about our Lord Jesus on earth are water, the Spirit, and the blood. **The water** is a physical witness. The Bible says, *“Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John. But John tried to deter him, saying, ‘I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?’ Jesus replied, ‘Let it be so now; it is proper for us to do this to fulfill all righteousness.’ Then John consented.”* Matthew 3:13-15 (NIV). The Lord Jesus was baptized to fulfill all righteousness, and we are to do likewise. Water baptism is a sacrament of the church, a physical expression of an inner spiritual reality.

**The Holy Spirit** is a physical witness. John 1:32–34 says, *“And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him. And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost. And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son*

*of God.*” (KJV). This is the confirmation as a witness. The Father, Son, and Holy Ghost in that ordinance is a convincing proof or evidence of the truth of Christianity. (Matthew 3:16-17)

**The blood** is also a physical sign and a witness. John the Baptist pointed to Jesus and said, *“Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.”* This spoke to His death, burial, and resurrection. John 19:34 explains, “Forthwith came there out blood and water.” Jesus was our Passover lamb. He shed his blood on the cross and died, to take away our sin, he delivered us from the kingdom of darkness to light, and to save us. He instituted the communion as a memorial, and testimony of His death, evidence of the truth of Christianity.

## **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Father, thank You for the undeniable witness of the water, the blood, and the Spirit. I boldly declare that Jesus Christ is Lord and Savior, proven and revealed through these eternal witnesses. I honor the baptism, I remember the communion, and I walk daily with the Holy Spirit, living proof of Your love and truth in my life. In the name of the Lord Jesus, Amen.

## **WISDOM NUGGET**

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*“Took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying ‘Drink of it, all of you, for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins’”* (Matt. 26:27-28).

## The Holy Spirit

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*“However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.”*

*John 16:13 (NKJV)*

In the beginning God (Genesis 1:1). You see the Trinity working as one in creation. God is introduced here as “Elohim”. “Elohim” in Hebrew is the plural of God. God is tri-part: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the third Person of the Godhead. In Genesis 1:1-2, the Bible records, *“the Spirit of God moved over the face of the deep.”* The Holy Spirit incubated the earth and God the Father spoke creation into existence, and the Word by which all things existed is the Lord Jesus. The Holy Spirit is the one who proceeds from the Father.

The Lord Jesus was born by the Holy Spirit and empowered by the Holy Spirit to accomplish His earthly ministry. The Lord Jesus, knowing the significance of the Holy Spirit, told the disciples to wait in Jerusalem to be endued by the Holy Spirit for Ministry. Luke 24:49 explains, *“And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.”* (KJV). The disciples followed His instruction,

and the Church was born (Acts 2).

The Holy Spirit is also known as “*Allos Parakletos*,” meaning another Comforter of the same kind. In Isaiah 63:9, he was revealed as “the angel of His presence.” Jesus said, “But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name...” (John 14:26). This implies that the Holy Spirit answers to Jesus’s name. The Holy Spirit is the presence of God everywhere at the same time. The Bible says, “For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father” (Ephesians 2:18). It is through the Holy Spirit that every believer has access to the Father. Our salvation is sealed with the Holy Spirit.

## PRAYER / CONFESSION

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Dear Father, Thank you, Lord, for the gift of the Holy Spirit—my helper, teacher, guide, advocate, intercessor, strengthener, and comforter. I walk in truth and operate in supernatural ability, fulfilling my purpose and making an eternal impact. In the name of the Lord Jesus, Amen.

## WISDOM NUGGET

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*“In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise” Ephesians 1:13 (KJV).*

## The Seven Spirits of God

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*“The Spirit of the LORD will rest on him, the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear the LORD”*

Isaiah 11:2 (NIV) (Revelation 3:1, Revelation 1:4, Revelation 5:6, Revelation 4:5).

The scripture above reveals the seven manifestations of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit rested on our Lord Jesus in full measure, which implies the “fullness” of the Holy Spirit, and every believer ought to have the same. The number seven represents perfection or completion. These are the seven manifestations of the Spirits of God. The Spirit of the Lord upon you anoints you for effective ministry. *“For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist.”* Luke 21:15 (KJV). *“Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.”* 1 Corinthians 2:12 (KJV). As you are constantly filled with the Holy Spirit, you will manifest His power in these seven dimensions to God's glory and for God's purpose.

## PRAYER / CONFESSION

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Dear Father, I thank You for the fullness of Your Spirit resting upon me. I receive and walk in the Spirit of the Lord, in wisdom, understanding, counsel, might, knowledge, and the fear of the Lord. I operate in divine insight, power, and purpose. I am led and equipped by Your Spirit to fulfill all that You have called me to do. In the name of the Lord Jesus, Amen.

### WISDOM NUGGET

## **Leaving an Inheritance**

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“A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children...”

Proverbs 13:22 (NKJV).

An inheritance is a continuing impact you make on and through those who outlive you for generations to come. The scripture above references “children’s children,” which means generational. To inherit is to receive by succession or by will as an heir legally entitled.

Leaving an inheritance allows you to live purposefully to impact your world even after you transition to heaven. To leave an inheritance, you must understand that everything you have is a gift from God, and you are a steward called to manage what is given to you for His purpose and to bless His people. Inheritance is for those connected genuinely by blood, covenant, and by revelation.

Five ways to leave an inheritance for generations.

1. By investing in your name.

Proverbs 22: 1 says, “A good name is to be chosen rather than great riches,” The value of a good name is a measure of your usefulness, contribution, credibility,

and track record, which becomes a key to opening doors.

2. By investing your convictions. your belief system and mindset. Raising your children that way.

Proverbs 22:6 says, "Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it." (KJV).

3. Through impartation of blessing.

This is the blessing and the grace you are functioning in. God blessed Abraham. Genesis 12:2. Abraham blessed Isaac. Isaac blessed Jacob. Jacob blessed Israel. You bless your children.

4. By investing in strategic relationships.

God relates to man and operates from man to man.

Lord Jesus invested in John, then gave His mother to him take care of her (John 19:26-27)

5. Invest in Assets: Insurance, Real estate, Business.

Abraham left inheritance for his children's children.

Under the Jewish law, inheritance was patrimonial. The father, to his male descendants. But in Numbers 27:1-11, the five daughters of Zelophehad come to Moses and ask for their father's inheritance, as they have no brothers to inherit. Moses took the matter to God, and God agreed with the five daughters of Zelophehad and changed the law. The new order of inheritance was set out: a man's sons inherit first, daughters if no sons, brothers if he has no children, and so on. Amazing.

Are you a good man? Then leave an inheritance for your children's children.

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Dear Father, I thank you for enlightening me on how to leave an inheritance for my children's children. I receive grace to act now by faith in the name of the Lord Jesus.

## The Gifts of The Holy Spirit

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*“Now there are [distinctive] varieties of spiritual gifts [special abilities given by the grace and extraordinary power of the Holy Spirit operating in believers], but it is the same Spirit [who grants them and empowers believers]. But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit [the spiritual illumination and the enabling of the Holy Spirit] for the common good.”*

1 Corinthians 12:4, 7 (AMP).

The Holy Spirit is the gift of God and He gives gifts to believers according as He wills, for the benefit of the body of Christ. But you can desire the gifts and walk in the manifestation of them. These gifts are supernatural abilities given by God to His children to advance His purpose on earth. The Bible says, *“To one is given through the [Holy] Spirit [the power to speak] the message of wisdom, and to another [the power to express] the word of knowledge and understanding according to the same Spirit; to another [wonder-working] faith [is given] by the same [Holy] Spirit, and to another the [extraordinary] gifts of healings by the one Spirit; and to another the working of miracles, and to another prophecy [foretelling the future, speaking a new message from God to the people], and to another discernment of spirits [the ability to distinguish sound,*

*godly doctrine from the deceptive doctrine of man-made religions and cults], to another various kinds of [unknown] tongues, and to another interpretation of tongues.”* 1 Corinthians 12:8-10 (AMP). These are the gifts enumerated:

The gifts of the Holy Spirit are 9, but they can further be classified into 3 categories.

1. Power gifts: These are action gifts a) Gift of Healing. b) Faith. c) Working of miracles

2. Utterance or vocal gifts. a) Prophecy (1 Corinthians 14:4 (NKJV). b) Interpretation of tongues. c) Speaking in diverse kinds of tongues (Acts 2:4,6)

3. Revelation gifts: to know and see the truth about a situation. a) Word of Wisdom (Luke 7:35 AMPC). b) Word of Knowledge. c) Discerning of spirits

Romans 12:6 says, *“Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith”*. Function in your gift according to the grace that is given to you, and according to the proportion of faith. Keep stirring up the gift of God in you, by praying constantly in the Holy Spirit, for greater exploits. *“For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance.”* Romans 11:29 (KJV). God does not take them away from you, so be a good steward of your gifts and use them for the common good of the body of Christ.

## **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Heavenly Father, I thank You for the gifts of the Holy Spirit at work in me. I am empowered by the same Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead. I stir up the gifts

within me: wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, tongues, and interpretation of tongues. I function in them with boldness, accuracy, and love for the edification of the body of Christ. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

### **WISDOM NUGGET**

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*[“That is why I would remind you to stir up \(rekindle the embers of, fan the flame of, and keep burning\) the \[gracious\] gift of God, \[the inner fire\] that is in you by means of the laying on of my hands \[with those of the elders at your ordination\] 2 Timothy 1:6 \(AMPC\).](#)*

## Receiving the Holy Spirit

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*“Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the LORD our God shall call.”*

Acts 2:38-39 (KJV)

The Holy Spirit is the gift of God for all those God has called (i.e. every born-again believer). Receiving the Holy Spirit means receiving the gift of God. 1 John 2:27 says, *“But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.”* (KJV). The Holy Spirit came to abide in you forever. He lives in your spirit and will teach and guide you in all things if you allow Him. He helps you to recognize wrong teaching and false prophets. He is the anointing by which you destroy yokes and burdens are lifted (Isaiah 10:27). The Holy Spirit empowers you from within and you are enabled to do what the Lord Jesus did and greater works as He has commanded us to do.

By faith, every child of God is entitled to receive the Holy Spirit, who is a gift from God

(Galatians 3:2). Do not take this lightly; it is for your benefit in living the victorious life in Christ.

## **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Lord, I thank You for the precious gift of the Holy Spirit. I believe and receive Him into my life by faith. The anointing abides in me, teaching and guiding me into all truth. I am empowered from within to walk in victory, destroy yokes, and discern truth from error. As a sign of Your promise, I speak in new tongues and yield completely to the Spirit's leading. I am full of the Holy Ghost and power, in Jesus' Name. Amen.

## Be Constantly Filled With the Holy Spirit

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*“And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery; but EVER be filled and stimulated with the [Holy] Spirit.”*

Ephesians 5:18 (AMPC).

In the above verse, Apostle Paul is admonishing believers who have already received the Holy Spirit to be constantly filled with the Spirit at all times. This is because God wants you to function at His level; the things of God are spiritually discerned. Receiving the Spirit and being filled with the Holy Spirit are not the same. When you receive Him, He comes to live in you. To be constantly filled means your spirit is to be immersed (synchronized) in Him.

One of the ways to be constantly filled in the Spirit is by *“Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord”* Ephesians 5:19. These are things you must do consciously, and by doing so your spirit is continually energized, the gifts of God are stirred, for greater victories and success always.

Another way to be filled in the Spirit, which is a more excellent way, is praying in tongues. *“And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with*

*boldness” Acts 4:31(KJV).* It was the infilling of the Holy Spirit that gave the Apostles boldness to speak the Word of God. You also build your faith and make continuous progress as you pray in the Holy Spirit (Jude 20).

The Holy Spirit makes intercession on your behalf as you pray in the Holy Ghost, and the devil cannot intercept. He causes everything to work together for your good (Romans 8:26).

### **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Father, I choose today and every day to be continually filled with the Holy Spirit. I set my heart on You, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs in worship. I pray in the Spirit, building up my faith and charging my inner man, and I overflow with boldness, insight, and divine energy. ## **Releasing the Right Sound Codes**

God designed His divine power to be released through words, but you must have the right words. You are to receive the right sound codes from the Holy Spirit, the master communicator. He helps you by telling you exactly what to say, then you affirm what He tells you for it to manifest.

The Bible admonishes us to pray always with all prayers and supplications in the Spirit (Ephesians 6:18), Ask the “Holy Spirit, to help you to pray accurately, then begin praying, singing, and worshiping the Lord in tongues, channeling your mind on your purpose (the concern), do this intensely, and soon enough, the gift of prophecy will be stirred from within you to prophesy and make declarations uttering the right sound codes to effect the changes you want in every aspect of your life, family, finances, job, business, ministry, and anything that concerns you.

Your mouth is the pen of the ready writer to write the Word on your heart. It is the stored Word of

God in your heart that the Holy Spirit brings to your remembrance in your time of need. So, keep writing the Word of God on your heart, through your faith proclamation. Out of your belly shall flow rivers of living waters (John 7:38): these are ideas, visions, solutions, new businesses, and the list goes on.

### **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Father, I thank you that the Holy Spirit gives me utterance, and I prophesy boldly. Rivers of living water flow out of me, bringing visions, ideas, and transformation. My tongue is anointed to release Your power, and my words are aligned with heaven's agenda. I speak life, healing, provision, and purpose. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

God gives the Ministry gifts for the Office of His calling. *“And no man taketh this honour unto himself, but he that is called of God, as was Aaron.”* Hebrews 5:4 (KJV). These offices cannot be desired, God must choose you as His official representative, commissioned and charged with His assignment; you will know it. Ephesians 1:1 explains, *“From Paul, chosen by God to be an apostle of Christ Jesus.”*(CEV). The offices are: Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor, and Teacher. Before the Lord Jesus chose the Apostles, He had an all-night prayer: *“And when it was day, he called unto him his disciples: and of them he chose twelve, whom also he named apostles”* Luke 6:13, KJV). The fivefold ministers are co-labourers with God with a serious mandate.

The opening scripture defines the purpose of the fivefold ministers: For the perfecting of the saints. For

the work of the ministry. For the edifying of the body of Christ. Till we all come in the unity of the faith. The knowledge of the Son of God. Unto a perfect man. Unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ. This is why the church must constantly pray for the five-fold ministers to remain focused on the task and be led by the Holy Spirit in delivering their assignments for the body of Christ.

### **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Lord God, I thank You for the fivefold ministry You have established for the perfecting of the saints. I honor the apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor, and teacher You have called and commissioned. I pray for strength, wisdom, and continued alignment with Your Spirit and the Word. Thank you for opening my eyes to my role in your house. I receive grace to walk in it with humility, boldness, and purpose. ## **Witnessing by the Power of the Holy Spirit**

Without the Holy Spirit in you, you could not be bold or be effective in witnessing. The Spirit grants you the boldness to stand up for Jesus Christ and defend the faith. Cultivate the habit of praying more in tongues and make up your mind to speak to someone about Jesus. As you open your mouth, the boldness of the Spirit will be stirred within you, and the Holy Spirit will put the right words in your mouth, and they will listen to you.

See a practical example of the boldness of the Spirit in the lives of the disciples: Acts 4:31 says, *“And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness”* (KJV). It was the infilling of the Holy Spirit that gave them the boldness to speak the Word of God.

The Gospel of the Lord Jesus is committed to your trust individually and collectively as a church. Dedicate yourself to spreading this good news in your world and the Lord is with you to confirm His Word with signs and wonders.

### **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Father, I thank you for the Holy Spirit who empowers me to be a bold and an effective witness of Jesus Christ. Focus on the unseen by calling the things that are not as if they are real until they manifest physically. Everything God has said in His Word belongs to you, if you can see it, you can have it. Give attention to the Word allowing the Holy Spirit to show you your inheritance.

I have exceedingly abundantly above what I asked according to the Holy Spirit at work in me in Jesus' name (Ephesians 3:20-21). Whatever I lay my hands on shall prosper (Psalm 1:3b). I have unlimited resources (Deuteronomy 8:17), and I hold fast to my confessions in Jesus' name.

## Types of Prayer

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*“Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”*

Philippians 4:6-7 (AMP).

It is important to understand why we pray, so you can pray effectively. The reason for prayer is that God has given everyone a will by which we make choices. Because of this, God can only recommend to us what to do. You have to, by choice, ask God into your space or situation. He cannot impose anything on man that will be against His principles. *“And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;”* Luke 18:1 (KJV). But do all men always pray? With the opening verse, we see that by prayer, petition with thanksgiving, making your requests known to God, protects you from anxiety. There are different types of prayer outlined for you in the Word of God:

Prayer of Faith. (James 1:5-8, 15). The key to this type of prayer is to ask in faith and not doubt.

Prayer of Petition. (Matthew 7:7) Persistence is the key in the prayer of petition; you reaffirm what God has said until change comes.

Prayer of Agreement. (Matthew 18:18-20). The key is that the hearts agree at the point of prayer.

Prayers of intercession. (1 Timothy 2:1-5). In the prayer of intercession, you are standing in the gap for another until change comes.

Prayer in the Spirit. (Romans 8:26-27) The Spirit Himself prays on your behalf.

Prayer of Worship, Praise, and Thanksgiving. (Psalm 105:1-4, Psalm 103). You sing songs of rejoicing, making melody in your heart to God.

## **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Father, I thank You for the privilege of prayer. I choose to engage in every kind of prayer You've provided: prayer of faith, petition, agreement, intercession, praise, and Spirit-led prayer. I refused to be anxious; instead, I pray with thanksgiving and trust You completely. I align my heart with Your Word, and I declare that Your peace rules over my mind and circumstances, in the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen.

## **Worship**

---

“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship Him”

John 4:23 (KJV).

The Church of our Lord Jesus Christ is a holy priesthood assigned to offer up spiritual sacrifices to God, and there are different kinds of sacrifices, one of which is the sacrifice of worship. Your functionality in the presence of God is a true honor and must be done reverently. God wants all His children to worship Him in Spirit and in truth.

True worship involves an inward attitude and posture of your heart in intimate koinonia with God, who is a Spirit, aligning your spirit with His, spirit-to-spirit. Philippians 3:3 says, “For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh” (KJV). In worship, you express from the depths of your heart love, gratitude, and reverence for God; thankfully confessing His character, love, mercy, and grace, appreciating His goodness, blessings, faithfulness, and righteousness.

The inner workings of the Holy Spirit and the Word of God enable you to serve Him with your spirit,

impacting your life, resources, skills, gifting, talent, and actions reflecting God's glory and purpose. Paul said, "For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of His Son" Romans 1:9, KJV). Develop a lifestyle by actively engaging your spirit, focusing on the Lord, and worshipping Him in spirit and truth.

Your priestly ministry toward God includes giving Him thanks, praising Him, and presenting our bodies to Him as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable (Romans 12:1). Psalm 145:21 says, “My mouth shall speak the praise of the Lord; and let all flesh bless (affectionately and gratefully praise) His

holy name forever and ever” (KJV). Your sacrifices of praise are with words, which means they must have content, voicing your reasons for praising Him.

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Dear Father, I offer You the sacrifice of praise continually. My mouth is filled with thanksgiving, and my heart overflows with worship. I lift my hands and honor You with a sincere heart. I worship You not just in words but through my service, my obedience, and my lifestyle. 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“But we ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters loved by the Lord because God chose you as firstfruits to be saved through the sanctifying work of the Spirit and through belief in the truth. He called you to this through our gospel that you might share in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.”

2 Thessalonians 2:13-14 (NIV).

In Christ Jesus, you are sanctified. The word “sanctification” is from the Greek word “hagiasmos” which means to be separated unto God, to be distinguished in Christ. Ephesians 1:4-5 says, “Even as [in His love] He chose us [actually picked us out for Himself as His own] in Christ before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy (consecrated and set apart for Him) and blameless in His sight, even above reproach, before Him in love. For He foreordained us (destined us, planned in love for us) to be adopted (revealed) as His own children through Jesus Christ, in accordance with the purpose of His will [because it pleased Him and was His kind intent]” (AMPC). Before the world existed, God already chose you in Christ Jesus to be holy, blameless, and loved according to His purpose.

God chose you to be saved through the sanctification of the Spirit by believing in the truth (the

Word). We are called by the gospel of Jesus Christ, not by works, lest any man should boast. The Spirit works in your heart, molding you, and producing spiritual fruits that reflect God's nature. Accept who God has made you and reckon it to be so in your life.

### **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Heavenly Father, I thank You that I have been sanctified, set apart, and made holy by Your Spirit and through faith in Jesus Christ. I walk in the reality of this sanctification daily, reflecting Your glory and fulfilling Your purpose for my life. I am distinguished in Christ and empowered to live above reproach, walking in love, and in holiness. In the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen.

## **You are redeemed**

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“In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God’s grace”  
Ephesians 1:7 (NIV).

The word “redemption” in the verse above in Greek is “apolutrosis,” which means deliverance. Redemption refers to saving someone by paying a price. When Jesus died, He paid all the price for sin and its consequences for man’s redemption with His own life, guaranteeing complete atonement for all men legally. He was the ransom to free us from the bondage of Satan.

“But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us ... redemption” 1 Corinthians 1:30 (KJV). Redemption was completed with the death of the Lord Jesus by shedding His blood, and we received forgiveness of sin. And every born-again child of God was translated from the kingdom of Satan to the kingdom of God by the blood. Without the shedding of blood, there will be no redemption. Note that the resurrection was necessary for our salvation.

Christianity came from the resurrection, not from Jesus’ death. We have been raised up together with Christ. Now you are in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto you redemption. Psalm 46:1 says, “God is

our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.” (KJV). Christ is your deliverance and your deliverer; your rescuer; a present help in times of trouble.

### **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Father, I thank You, Lord Jesus, for redeeming me with Your precious blood. I declare that I am free from every bondage, curse, and accusation of the enemy. I have been delivered from the power of darkness and translated into Your glorious Kingdom. Christ is my redemption and my deliverance. I walk boldly in the liberty You purchased for me. In the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen.

### **WISDOM NUGGET**

Romans 5:1 (KJV).

To be justified by faith means you are divinely acquitted and declared not guilty. This is because the finished (death, burial, and resurrection) of the Lord Jesus on our behalf. The Bible says, “Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.” Galatians 2:16 (KJV). You did not work for your justification, it is by the faith of the Lord Jesus Christ; therefore, live free of condemnation by the faith of Jesus.

1 Timothy 3:16 says, “ And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.” (KJV). He was justified in the Spirit. Because He was made sin for us, His resurrection brought us justification. This is the gospel. Receive it and walk in victory, being justified by faith, you have peace with God.

## **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Father, I declare I am justified by faith in Jesus Christ. I live free from guilt, shame, and condemnation. I have peace with You, and I boldly access Your grace. I am not moved by what I see but by the finished work of Jesus Christ, through whom I am declared righteous and live victoriously. In the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen.

## New Testament Church Sacraments

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*“I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD.”*  
Psalms 122:1 (KJV)

The church is the place for perfecting God’s saints. The Bible says He (Christ), “...gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up” Ephesians 4:11-12 (NIV). It is God’s blueprint that we are taught by His fivefold ministers, either by their spoken word or by their letters to the churches. We are to stand firm and hold to the sacraments, the patterns we have been taught (not as a religion). Every member is required to become effective, utilizing their gifts and talents in the Kingdom of God.

The Lord Jesus said, “*Ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you*” John 15:3 (KJV). You are cleansed by the Word of God and empowered to live out the Word so that you do not walk in error, and so you can be the light, an example to the world.

The church is a place where your faith grows, hope comes alive, and you receive solutions, because you are taught the Word of God, and the knowledge of God’s Word gives you an advantage in life. Cultivate personal discipline and make it a priority to be present

in your local church consistently, in the fellowship of the brethren. The Bible says that in the unity of fellowship, the Lord commands the blessing, even life for evermore.

There is no excuse for not going to church. If some particular situations or challenges hinder your church attendance physically, participate in the live services through the online platforms available, until change comes. So much emphasis is placed on the importance of fellowship with the brethren.

### **PRAYER / CONFESSION**

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Dear Father, I thank You for placing me in the body of Christ where I am taught, cleansed, and equipped through Your Word by the fivefold ministers. I honor the sacraments of the church and remain faithful in fellowship, and actively use my gifts to promote the Kingdom of God on this earth in the name of the Lord Jesus.

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*“Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle” 2 Thessalonians 2:15 (KJV).*



# SALVATION

*All of us like sheep have gone astray, we have  
turned, each one, to his own way; But  
the Lord has caused the wickedness of us all [our  
sin, our injustice, our wrongdoing] to fall on Him  
[instead of us]"*  
— Isaiah 53:6 (AMP)

The whole human race went astray because of the sin of the first Adam, and God laid all our sins on Jesus. 2 Corinthians 5:21 explains, “*He made Christ who knew no sin to [judicially] be sin on our behalf so that in Him we would become the righteousness of God [that is, we would be made acceptable to Him and placed in a right relationship with Him by His gracious lovingkindness]*” (AMP). Our Lord Jesus took your place legally so you would become the righteousness of God.

To receive Him, you must be born again: *Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.*” John 3:3, 7 (KJV). The term “born again” was originally used by

Jesus to express the necessity for man's spiritual rebirth. *"But to as many, as did receive and welcome Him, He gave the right [the authority, the privilege] to become children of God, that is, to those who believe in (adhere to, trust in, and rely on) His name"* John 1:12 (APM). To be born again is by receiving Jesus as your Lord and Savior.

The new birth is a one-time experience. By choosing the Lord Jesus as Lord of your life, you receive remission of sin. Remission is the complete removal of sin which the blood of Jesus gives, giving you a new nature of righteousness, and giving you right standing before God without a sense of guilt or condemnation. The Bible says, *"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation"* Romans 10:9-10 (KJV). Confession is your response in agreement with God's Word.

### **To Receive Your Gift of Salvation Today:**

Please say this prayer and mean it from your heart:

*"Father, I come to you in the name of Jesus. I confess Jesus as Lord of my life, and I believe in*

*my heart that He died for my sins and that you raised Him from the dead. I am saved. I am born again. I have eternal life, and I am a new creation."*

### **Congratulations!**

You are now a child of God in whom Jesus dwells by the Holy Spirit. The Bible says, *"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new"* 2 Corinthians 5:17 (KJV). You are a new creature without a past and are to live a dedicated life under the lordship of Christ Jesus. As a child of God, you live in this spiritual kingdom where the Lord Jesus reigns (Colossians 1:13). With the confession you made, spiritually, your spirit is as new as a baby born today. The Bible says, *"As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the Word that ye may grow thereby"* 1 Peter 2:2 (KJV). Just as natural newborn baby's desire milk, spiritual newborns must also desire the Word of God, to build up faith, and grow their spirits. When we are born again, it is our spirit that is born again. Your flesh and thoughts are still the same. Therefore, the Word of God is important to renew your mind (Romans 12:2) so you can think the way God thinks (Romans 12:3) and live the Spirit life.

I pray that God our Father grants you revelation in the knowledge of Himself, causing grace and peace to be multiplied to you. I pray that you are protected from the evil one and that you stand perfect in the will of God in the name of the Lord Jesus. Amen.

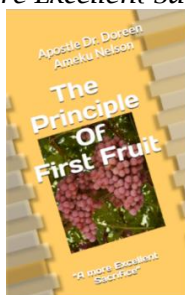

*“A More Excellent Sacrifice”*

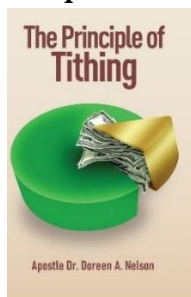

fruit simply refers to the initial or the first harvest of one's labor or services rendered.

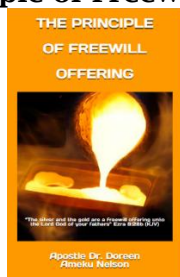
## **The Principle of Tithing**

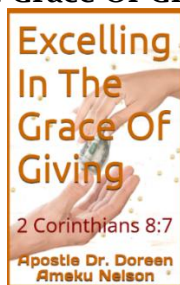
## Believe God's Prophet and You Shall Prosper

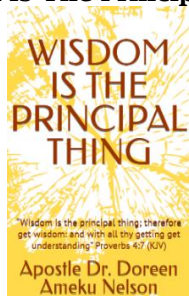
## **Excelling In The Grace Of Giving**

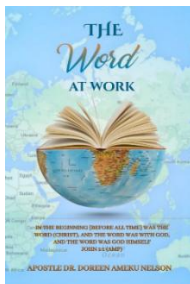

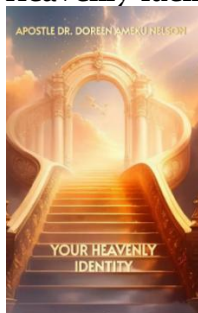
